

The Adult Education committee offers several speakers between now and Shavuot:

- March 21st, Dr. Michelle Green Wilner, composer & conductor. She speaks before Mincha on *The Hidden Miracle: Noña Garcia Nasi and the Courage of an Eshet Chayil*, whose music weaves poetry, folklore, prayer, and Judaic history into vivid storytelling. Her works have been presented at venues including the Jerusalem Biennale, 92nd Street Y, Museum of Tolerance, LA Jewish Symphony, and San Francisco's Hot Air Music Festival, as well as at the Judy Frankel Memorial Concert featuring her opera-in-progress *La Señora*. A recipient of twelve ASCAP Awards and numerous honors including Brian M. Israel Prize, SOCAN's Serge Garant Award, Bruce Geller Memorial Prize, NLAPW First Place 2024 Biennial Music Competition, Max Helfman Fellowship, Mellon Fellowship, and Columbia University's President's Fellow. Dr. Green Willner has spoken at the Cantors' Assembly of America, Jerusalem Biennale, Jewish Heritage Alliance/ ANU Museum of the Jewish People, Tel Aviv, and Nowakowsky International Jewish Choral Festival. She holds a doctorate in musical arts from Columbia University and currently directs the MGW Singers and the LA Jewish Community Children's Choir.
